

Christ Church Riverside meeting at The Beverley Barn (updated 9/8/20)

Hi, it's great that you are going to join us for our Riverside meeting at The Beverley Barn. Here are a few guidelines we need to follow to help keep everyone safe.

First and hopefully most obviously, if you are showing any Covid-19 symptoms or have had a positive test please don't come! Symptoms include high temperature, a new, continuous cough and a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste. If you have any of these, stay at home and follow the government advice on isolation.

Also, if you are shielding or classed as vulnerable, we ask that you please stay at home and watch on youtube.

You need to let us know you are coming so we can arrange suitably distanced seating and control numbers of people. If you haven't already, please tell Pete or your homegroup leader that you're coming. We will assume that this will be the same from week to week, so you only need to tell us if you want to start coming when you were previously at home, or if you normally come but will be missing a service.

It is legally required that you wear a face covering while in the building, unless you are exempt from wearing one. Also, please sanitise your hands when entering and leaving the building using the sanitiser which will be at the door.

At the front we will have a clear screen for the service leader to stand behind so they can safely take off their face covering while speaking. If you're going up to read or pray you can also take off your face covering while you are speaking.

We will allocate groups of seating in families / groups / social bubbles with suitable spacing. When you get in the building please go to your seats as directed by the person on the door. Please keep to the 2 metre separation rule while inside the building and outside afterwards.

There are separate male and female toilet rooms. Although there are multiple toilets in each room, there is not much space so we will try to have only one person / group / family in the toilet rooms at any time. Please wait outside the door if someone is in there. Please use the sanitiser provided before you come out.

If you have children, please can you try to keep them close to you as much as possible. Some people are still feeling anxious about the virus and are worried about children running up to them. Also please can you accompany children aged 11 and under to the toilet if needed.

During the sermon (which will be short), we are going to organise some sort of activity for the children outside (if fine) or in another part of the barn (if wet). Please can a parent/carer accompany their children for this activity.

There is an onsite cafe which will be selling refreshments afterwards. If you visit the cafe, please follow their guidelines.
